Burglary Prevention Tips

Know your neighbors.

Don't let strangers inside. Use your locks.

Vehicle Safety

Lock and secure your vehicle at

all times.

Do not leave any items visible in your vehicle regardless of value.

Control access to your keys.

Inventory Your Valuables

Keep a personal property inventory record of brand, model, serial number, value and the date an item was purchased.

Store a duplicate copy of your inventory record away from your home.

PROPERTY AUDIT

Free audits are available for residences, neighborhoods, small businesses, rental properties, and apartment communitites.

Experts will provide information on deterring criminal behavior through physical design elements, such as lighting, landscaping and parking lot safety.
